Desk Research Snapshot

Spain is advancing inclusive and sustainable urban development through smart mobility, accessible public spaces, and youth-focused planning, though rural gaps and green washing concerns remain.



Key Insights

- Smart Cities: Madrid and Barcelona lead in sustainable mobility.
- Services like Renfe's Atendo support inclusive travel.
- Inclusive Green Spaces:
 Parks like Madrid Río are designed for all abilities.
- Youth Inclusion: National strategy promotes youth participation in planning.
- Urban-Rural Gap: Rural areas lag in accessibility and infrastructure.
- **Disability Metrics:** City inclusivity scores show room for growth.

Focus Groups

Two (2) online focus groups.

Who took part?

26 total participants in April 2025.

Key Findings

- 1. Urban-Rural Divide.
- 2. Positive Urban Practices.
- 3. Some participants questioned whether sustainability efforts are genuine or just "green washing."



Insights

Urban progress with purpose - empowering youth through inclusion and sustainability.

Recommendations

Expand accessible transport and green infrastructure to ensure inclusive, sustainable urban development for all.

In Madrid, over 80% of Metro stations are accessible, while in Barcelona, this figure exceeds 90%. Local buses in both cities are 100% accessible
